ACTIVE MILITARY PERSONNEL

- **NOT ELIGIBLE**
 - Contractors
 - Foreign Affiliate
 - Civilian
- “Cadets” are eligible



DD FORM 2 RESERVES

- Members of the Individual Ready Reserves and Inactive National Guard



DD FORM 2 RETIRED

- Retired members entitled to retired pay
- Members on the Temporary Disability Retired List (TDRL)
- Members on the Permanent Disability Retired List (PDRL)



DD FORM 1173/DD FORM 2765

- 100% Disabled Veterans
- Medal of Honor recipients
- Some retirees
- Spouses and/or dependents of active



DD FORM 2 RESERVE RETIRED/DD FORM 1173-1

- Retired members of the Reserves and National Guard under the age of 60
- Dependents of: Reserve members not on Active Duty or in receipt of retired pay



STATE ISSUED ID or US DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS ID

- Veterans of the U.S. Military
- State issued id's must have a qualifying identifier
